Materials publication

It is planned to publish abstracts and materials of the conference. Best topics will be published in international scientific journal (NanoScale Research Letters) and in a Springer book dedicated to the Conference. Abstracts will be published before the start of the conference providing that abstracts were received in time and in proper format and fee for publication was paid before June 15, 2017. Publication fee for publication in the Book of Abstracts is:

- •50 EUR for non-Ukrainian residents;
- •500 UAH for Ukrainian residents;
- •250 UAH for Ph.D. students.

Abstracts must be prepared in English and must not exceed 1 page which includes pictures, tables, photos and references.
